

## Electric Vehicle and Charging Station Resources:

### **Model Ordinances**

- The State of *New Jersey* created a [model ordinance](#) template for the implementation of electric vehicle charging stations after Governor Murphy signed into law a requirement that “Electric Vehicle Supply/Service Equipment (EVSE) and Make-Ready parking spaces be designated as a permitted accessory use in all zoning or use districts.” The ordinance also establishes associated installation and parking requirements.
- In April of 2022, *Temple University* created a [model ordinance](#) guide containing in depth guidance regarding considerations and policy for the integration of electric vehicle charging stations.

### **Funding Sources**

The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection offers two primary funding programs for EV charging stations:

- [Driving PA Forward](#)- provides Level 2 Light-Duty Vehicle Charging Equipment Rebates and Electric Vehicle Fast Charging or Hydrogen Fuel Cell Equipment Grants
- [Alternative Fuels Incentive Grant \(AFIG\)](#)- provides funding to offset the cost of alternative fuel vehicles and their charging/fueling infrastructure
